They are not permitted to participate in the outdoor lawn bowling activities.</p> <p>They shall not be entitled to the rights, privileges, and prerogatives of Club membership and shall not have the right to vote, hold office or to have any proprietary interest in the Club’s assets.</p>

<p>Junior members are individuals between 9 and 19 years of age who have paid the appropriate full current Junior membership fees, and who are not under suspension. They are entitled to participate in all activities of the Club.</p> <p>They shall enjoy all the rights, privileges, and prerogatives of Club membership, except the right to vote, to hold office and to have any proprietary interest in the Club’s assets.</p>
